


Installation

- Make sure the Groundfridge is placed in a safe and easily-accessible location.
- Please ensure that your Groundfridge mound slopes at a safe angle. In doing so, take account of the type soil you are using on your mound as this will greatly determine the extent to which it may be exposed to risk of erosion or landsliding.
- Always follow the Groundfridge Installation Manual when installing your Groundfridge.
- We recommend that you call in certified professionals to help with the required digging work and the installation of your Groundfridge.



Using your Groundfridge

- The Groundfridge should never be occupied by more than two persons at any one time.
- Please take great care when stepping inside the Groundfridge and making your way down the steps. They could be covered with dirt and moisture and could hence prove a hazardous undertaking.
- Please ensure that the Groundfridge door is kept open whenever anyone is inside the Groundfridge. Make sure the wind doesn't slam your Groundfridge door shut with you, or anyone else inside. Always either tell someone else you're going down into the Groundfridge, or take a mobile phone down there with you.
- Only ever use the Groundfridge for storage purposes and never as a place to stay.
- Take care to conduct weekly inspections of your (mechanical) ventilation system, as well as its battery. Make sure vents are always kept clear. Please also check your lighting on a regular basis.
- Never operate any oxygen-consuming equipment inside your Groundfridge.
- Do not light any candles inside your Groundfridge. Do not light any fires inside your Groundfridge, or take anything burning inside.
- Do not stack its shelves with more than 500 kg of supplies.
- Make sure to evenly divide the weight of the products you're storing over the shelves.
- Your Groundfridge mound should not be loaded with anything in excess of a mass of 50 kg/m². No more than one person should ever climb the mound at any one time.
- Your shelves are not for climbing.
- Minors are to always enter the Groundfridge in the company of a grown-up. Do not start using your Groundfridge before its installation is fully completed.
- Always be careful when getting into, or stepping out of, the Groundfridge. Keep one hand on the banister at all times. Do not stay inside the Groundfridge for more than fifteen minutes.
- Only ever use organic cleaning agents on your Groundfridge.
- Please make sure that you have inspected all parts of your Groundfridge before you begin using it.
- Ensuring that all users of the Groundfridge are fully aware of any warnings and safety instructions that might apply when using the Groundfridge remains the sole responsibility of its owner.
- Never leave any products on either the Groundfridge stairs or flooring, as this might create a tripping hazard.
- Please check to see if the hoisting lugs are technically sound before moving or relocating your Groundfridge.
- Keep your installation manual and safety instructions for future reference.
- Always consult with your supplier if any unforeseen situation or issue arises in relation to your Groundfridge.
